

International Day against Police Brutality

On **15.03.2020**, the International Day Against Police Brutality, the campaign "Death in Custody" invites you to a nationwide demonstration in Berlin-Moabit. Death in Custody is an alliance of various anti-racist, anti-colonialist groups and individuals.

Time and again in Germany black people and people of colour die in police custody and other state institutions. The victims are often criminalised, the circumstances of the case on the part of the authorities are covered up while the perpetrators emerge unscathed and, in the dominant white German society, silence on deaths prevails. The deaths in custody of racially-targeted persons has a long tradition in Germany and Europe. Together we can take to the streets against this colonial-racist system and break the silence! In memory of the victims and in solidarity with families we demand the complete clarification of deaths, the conviction of perpetrators, the strengthening of the rights of those affected, and effective consequences at all levels of society to prevent further deaths!
